Description

Do you feel your students are passive and indifferent in class? They don't ask and when you have a question for them, there is either no response or it is just the same few students who talk to you. But most of your students just passively hang in their chairs.

It doesn't have to be this way! Wouldn't it be awesome if your students actively participated in class? If they thought and worked along, asked questions, exchanged their ideas with others, responded to your questions and –eventually– learned in a better, more motivated and sustainable way?

- develop settings for sustainable learning that promote student activation and motivation,
- enhance the quality of your instruction.
