The newly established Heisenberg Professor/Chair in Sensory Physiology at the OVGU Magdeburg investigates the neural basis of perceptual decision-making in primates.

Tasks:

- working on the project „The dynamics of neuronal population signalling during the temporal flow of perceptual events“ funded by the DFG (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft)
- investigating the relationship between neurophysiological measures and perceptual report using models and paradigms requiring continuous monitoring of visual input with reports at variable time intervals in primates
- collaborating within a multi-disciplinary team and taking responsibility for research progress and research reporting, presentations at scientific meetings etc.

Requirements:

- master/diploma and a PhD (or close to submission) in neuroscience, medicine, or another natural science and a strong quantitative background
- experience in either animal neurophysiology and/or neuro-computational approaches
- previous experience with non-human primate research is desirable but not essential, but a strong motivation to engage actively with these experimental approaches is required.
- experience in programming, for example with MATLAB or Python, and in statistical methods
- excellent language skills in English (German language skills are welcome but not essential)
- confidence and motivation to develop data analysis techniques and drive the project forward
